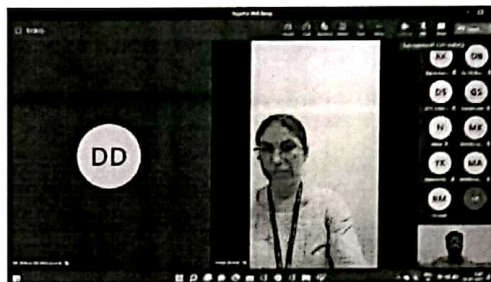






### Webinar on “Yoga for wellbeing”:
