

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) CELL

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) is an integral part of Research and Development and plays significant role in the standing of universities globally. Prior to the emergence of WTO agreement in 2005, India had availed the opportunity of Process Patenting and emerged as a global competitor. However, as per above mentioned WTO agreement, India had to go for Product Patenting rather than Process Patenting, and was deprived of this exceptional advantage.

Intellectual property right pertains to Patent, Copy Rights, Trade Marks, Design Registration, Plant Variety, Trade Secrets and Geographical Indications. Research and innovation emerge from Industries, National Laboratories or Centres, Universities and academic institutions of higher learning. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the university and academic institutions to educate and create awareness among the young researchers and also develop a conducive environment with respect to research and innovation and impart knowledge related to patents, Copyright, Geographical Indication etc. so that they can protect their Intellectual Property Rights.

Therefore, taking into consideration the above mentioned significant role and responsibilities, BUEST established Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell on 11 January, 2013. Dean R&D in association with Associate Dean, IPR were given the responsibility.

- > To guide and advise researchers searching, analysis, patent drafting and patent filling.
- > To provide IPR protection information orientation and facilities to the university researchers, faculty and students.
- > To get necessary clearances from the competent authorities while filing patents and other IPR, like copy right registration and designing registration etc.
- > To workout modalities on behalf of university for commercialization of patented technologies.
