Ph.D. Admission Policy

1. Objective

The objective of this policy is to outline the admission process, eligibility criteria, and selection procedures for the Ph.D. programs offered at Baddi University of Emerging Sciences & Technology.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must possess a Master's degree in a relevant field from a recognized university with a minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST candidates).
- An M.Phil. degree or any equivalent qualification will also be considered.
- Candidates who have qualified for national-level tests (UGC-NET, GATE, etc.) may be given preference.

3. Application Process

- Applications must be submitted through the official online portal of Baddi University.
- The application should include the following:
 - Completed application form.
 - Copies of academic transcripts and relevant certificates.
 - Statement of purpose (SOP) outlining research interests.
 - \circ Two reference letters from academic or professional mentors.

4. Admission Test

- An entrance test will be conducted to assess the candidate's research aptitude and relevant subject knowledge.
- The test will be followed by an interview conducted by an expert panel.
