OFFICE ORDER

Subject:- University-Level Anti-Ragging Committee and Squads, and Enforcement of UGC Guidelines for the Academic Session 2026-27.

Ref:- In compliance with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the University Grants Commission (UGC) formulated the 'UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009,' which were notified on 17th June 2009 and are mandatory for all universities and colleges to implement

In accordance with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the guidelines issued by the UGC, BUEST has established a University-level Anti-Ragging Committee and Squads to monitor various areas of the campus and ensure effective implementation of the prescribed regulations.

1. Anti-Ragging Committee:-

Punishments: - As per UGC Letter No. F.1-16/2007 (CCP-III) dated June 17, 2009, the University Grants Commission has reiterated a complete ban on ragging in educational institutions. Based on the severity and nature of the act, as determined by the Institute's Anti-Ragging Committee, strict disciplinary actions may be taken against offenders. The punishments may include one or more of the following:

- 1) Cancellation of Admission – Immediate termination of the offender's admission to the institution.
- 2) Academic Suspension – Temporary suspension from attending academic activities including classes, labs, or exams.
- 3) Loss of Financial Support – Withdrawal or cancellation of scholarships, fellowships, or any other financial aid.

- 4) Examination Bar – Restriction from appearing in internal assessments, university exams, or other evaluation processes.
- 5) Withholding of Academic Results – Results of ongoing or previous examinations may be withheld or cancelled.
- 6) Loss of Representation Privileges – Debarment from participating in university teams or events at regional, national, or international levels.
- 7) Hostel Disciplinary Action – Suspension or permanent expulsion from hostel accommodation.
- 8) Rustication/Expulsion – Suspension for one to four semesters or permanent expulsion from the institution, with a ban on future admission to any institution.
- 9) Monetary Penalty & Collective Action – Imposition of fines up to Rs. 50,000/-. If the individual responsible cannot be identified, collective punishment may be imposed to ensure accountability.

As per the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations (2009), all students are required to submit an Anti-Ragging affidavit at the time of initial registration and annually thereafter.

The students are to follow the procedure as given below:-

1. Log on to www.antiragging.in or www.amanmovement.org
2. Fill the information as requested.
3. Student will receive the affidavit through e-mail.
4. This must be printed and submitted to University / College at the time of Admission.

The Anti-Ragging Squads shall submit reports to the Proctor for necessary action. The Proctor will ensure in consultation with Deans/HoDs that all students of their respective school/Department must submit the annual online Anti-Ragging Affidavit online and the reference number of the same to academic branch.

Any case of ragging victim identified by the squad or reported by any victim will be referred to the anti-ragging committee, the meeting of which will be held at the earliest and the minutes of the meeting must be submitted to the Registrar's Office.
